The session was highly engaging, informative, and interactive. The officers explained traffic rules in a simple and relatable manner, while emphasising the importance of road safety,

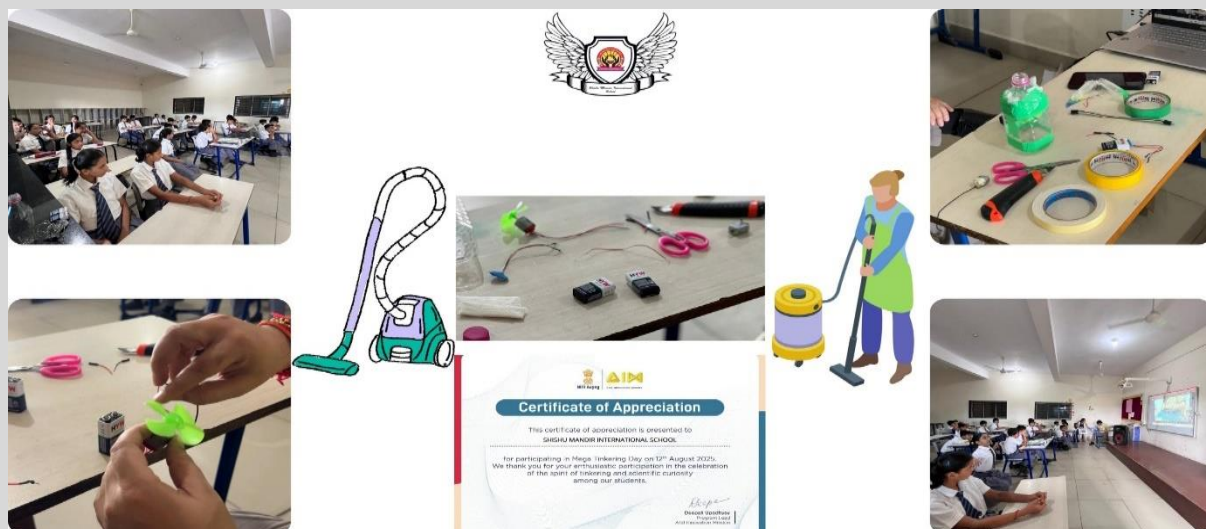
responsible driving, and pedestrian awareness. The use of real-life examples and visual aids made the learning impactful and memorable for our students.
