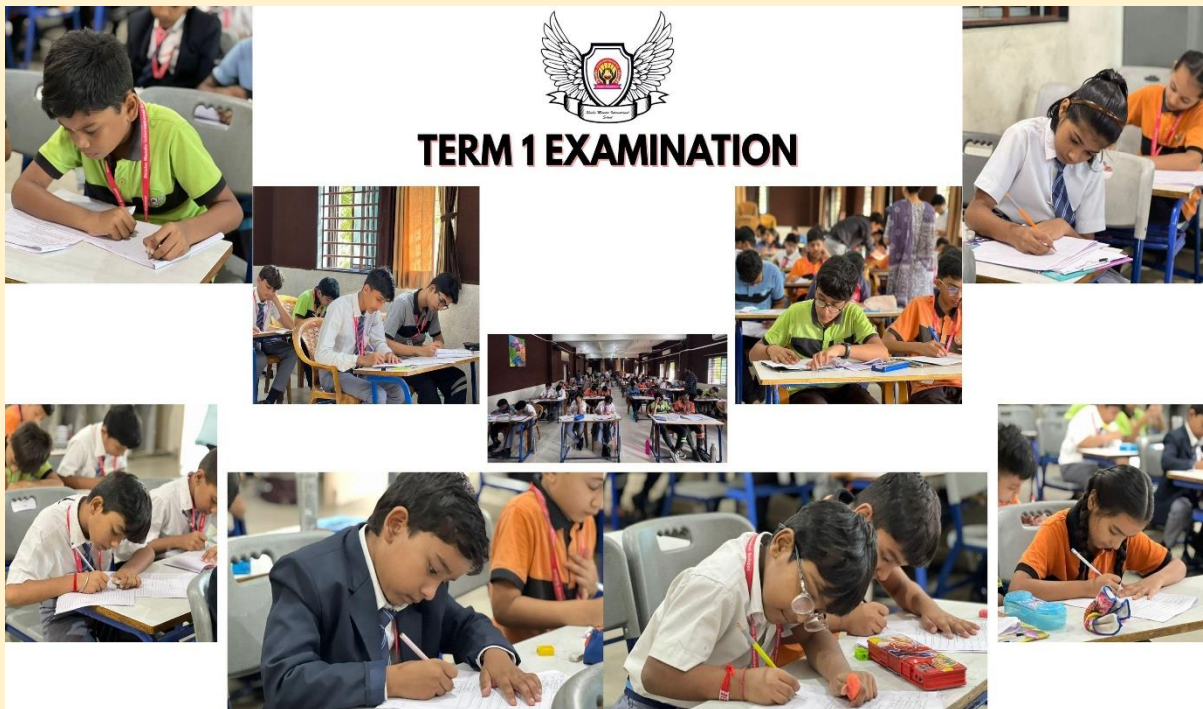
Term-I Examination-2025

CBSE Reading Challenge – Round II

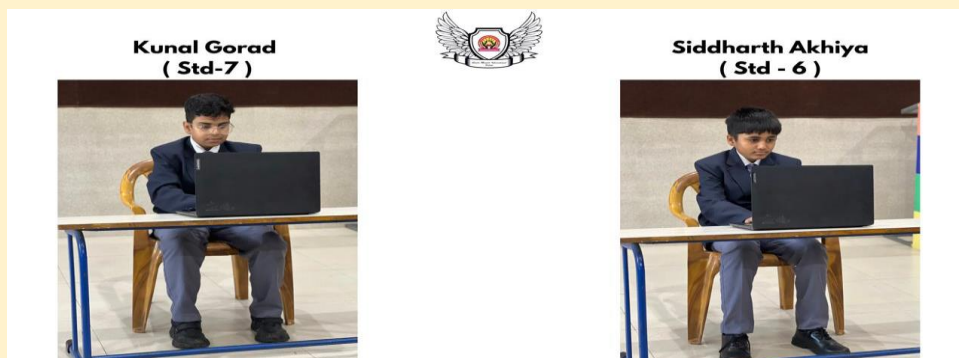
"Reading is not just about decoding words, it is about unlocking imagination and discovering a world beyond the printed page."
