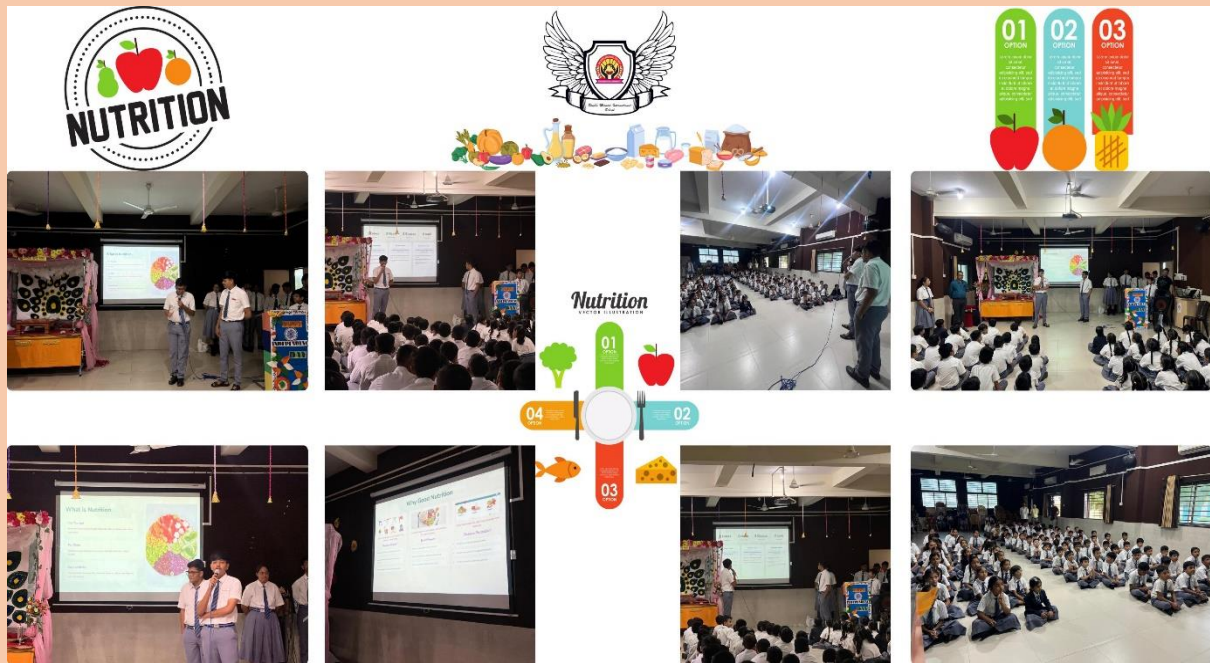

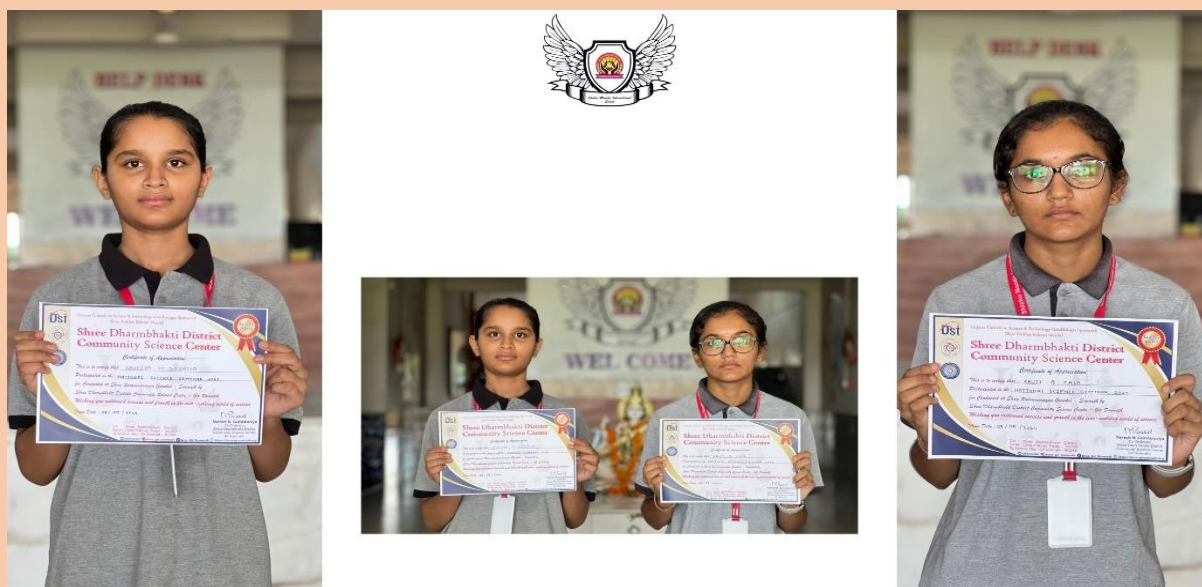
His dedication, creativity, and artistic excellence reflect not only his personal passion but also the nurturing environment provided by the school and the constant encouragement from teachers and parents.
